lightning provides 32 books with 3 levels of differentiation per book whole texts that provide nls genre coverage linked themes across fiction non fiction and the wider curriculum focussed teaching support for each book including comprehension and writing activities and a teaching and practice cd that provides opportunities for ict

while many books have been written about basic literacy few offer detailed information on how to plan and carry out a community literacy project fewer still give guidance in tackling the additional barriers of language culture and logistics in developing countries and in treating the local community as an active partner rather than a passive recipient in the literacy process in local literacies theory and practice glenys waters includes these elements and presents a practical guide for developing a literacy program beginning with a discussion of the theories of learning and reading the author provides a detailed description of how to plan and organize a literacy program when the practitioner has little to go on but wit knowledge and determination with approximately one half of the book given to the development of instructional methods and materials in reading writing and basic math local literacies will be especially helpful to those doing literacy work in linguistically diverse settings in much of the developing world the reader will quickly discover that this is a book written by a person who has been there and done that waters has spent more

than twenty years in australia and papua new guinea both as a practitioner and a consultant in programs of literacy for adults and children this personal experience plus a thorough knowledge of the professional literature makes local literacies a must for the pioneering literacy worker

first published in 2001 an inclusive education is one which seeks to respond to individual differences through an entitlement of all learners to common curricula armstrong and barton 2000 this book attempts to respond to this definition of inclusion by examining the principles of the literacy curriculum and a range of pedagogic practices the complex relationships between inclusion literacy and learning are acknowledged and it is argued that quality learning in language and literacy can work towards increased equity and involvement within the classroom community

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the programme organisers consist of one book per year provides an overview of the series including the rationale behind the programme structure and how it links with the nls correlation charts assessment sheets and an analysis of children s reading behaviours

bookwise is a carefully graded reading scheme organized into five cross curricular strands encouraging links to other subjects comprising 16 fiction and ten non fiction titles the 25 books at each level span a two year reading age and the three tier levelling system within each level facilitates an accurate match of reading ability and text the full colour readers are accompanied

by teacher s guides and resource sheets to help teachers get the most out of their guided reading and writing sessions

the pm teacher s guides offer invaluable support and guidance to help you gain the maximum benefit from each of the story books non fiction books and traditional tales and plays

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this book hopes to encourage people to examine the shapes and patterns which form the background of human life

find the right balance between all aspects of literacy learning including reading writing speaking and digital literacy and fit it all into a daily 100 minute literacy block

teachers notes accompany each reading book and include activities for follow up work step by step guidance on running the session suitable for both teachers and classroom assistants a detailed synopsis of the book and activities for developing writing and comprehension skills

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
