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emotional bridges to puerto rico examines the experiences of incorporation among two groups of middle class puerto ricans one that currently lives in the u s mainland and one that has resettled in puerto rico the analysis focuses on their subjective interpretations of incorporation and the conditions under which they decide to move back and forth between the mainland and island findings reveal that migration to the mainland results in educational occupational and economic gains in the u s which also help return migrants re enter island labor markets u s settlement brings its own set of struggles puerto ricans see themselves as members of transnational families yet the struggles of leading dual lives result in settlement decisions that reflect desires to live locally with roots in one place instead of feeling split between the two experiences with u s racism complicate these decisions given puerto ricans struggles with racial identity and exclusion in spite of their economic occupational and residential integration into mainland society this study illustrates the conditions under which various patterns of attachments to place or emotional anchoring develop and how these feelings impact future puerto rican settlement

what if puerto rico s story isn t simply one of colonial control but of resistance identity and the struggle for dignity in puerto rico freedom and power in the caribbean gordon k lewis immerses you in the island s modern crisis not as a passive victim of imperial forces but as a nation striving to claim its voice amid competing powers lewis captures the tensions of u s influence internal political fault lines and cultural resilience he tells how sugar barons u s governors nationalist leaders and everyday people shaped and were shaped by each other from the early twentieth century to mid century he examines the inequalities of plantation economics the yearning for autonomy and the dramatic social movements that challenged the island s dependency this is not dry political history lewis combines narrative sweep with analytical power the impact of quotas and capital flows the psychology of colonialism and the power struggles within parties he reveals how the quest for freedom often coexists with power for whom the island s progress is built and who pays its hidden costs still widely read today this work demands attention from anyone who seeks to understand not just puerto rico but modern colonial dynamics in the caribbean and beyond

while 1998 marked the 100th anniversary of the united states invasion and takeover of puerto rico it wasn t until 1999 that the island s political movements reappeared on the radar screen of the american people that year two major developments occurred that transformed the relationship between puerto rico and washington d c the limited clemency granted by then president clinton to eleven puerto rican nationalists and the death of puerto rican civilian security guard david sanes killed by missile fragments from u s naval bombing tests on the island municipality of vieques how does vieques fit into the political future of puerto rico while anti navy protesters are careful not to mix the island s political status options with their battle against the navy it is important to understand the role washington has played in shaping puerto rico s current reality and how it has allowed the navy to use vieques as a bombing range for 60 years it also helps one begin to predict what is the future of puerto rico is it to be a colony fifty first state of the united states

sovereign nation in islands of resistance mario a murillo approaches these questions by examining how puerto rican politics have been shaped as much by 100 years of u s economic military and cultural domination of the territory as by the enduring grassroots resistance of the puerto rican people islands of resistance puts the contemporary situation in puerto rico into an historic context that will help people understand what is at stake in vieques not only for viequenses but for puerto ricans both on the island and in the diaspora

available for the first time in english cruz miguel ortiz cuadra s magisterial history of the foods and eating habits of puerto rico unfolds into an examination of puerto rican society from the spanish conquest to the present each chapter is centered on an iconic puerto rican foodstuff from rice and cornmeal to beans roots herbs fish and meat ortiz shows how their production and consumption connects with race ethnicity gender social class and cultural appropriation in puerto rico using a multidisciplinary approach and a sweeping array of sources ortiz asks whether puerto ricans really still are what they ate whether judging by a host of social and economic factors or by the foods once eaten that have now disappeared ortiz concludes that the nature of daily life in puerto rico has experienced a sea change
